



## Lindab Access door EPFH

Mounting instruction



## Access door EPFH with bayonet locking



- 1. Push the cover onto the fitting and make sure the cover is secure and level all around (Fig. 1).
- 2. Mark the holes for the rivets (Fig. 2).
- 3. Remove the cover (Fig. 3).
- 4. Drill holes for the rivets (Fig. 3).
- 5. Insert the rivets so that they extend past the drilled holes. The recommended size of rivet is Ø 4,0 in 9,5 mm length.
- 6. Push the cover back onto the fitting so the rivets enter the slots (Fig 4).
- 7. Turn the cover clockwise to lock it into place (Fig. 4).
